He shared information with those in attendance regarding the department's TRIM grant which is a competitive, cost-share tree care program that provides reimbursement of

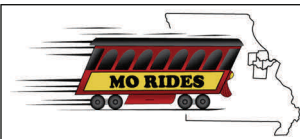

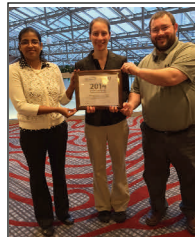
## Some Annual Meeting Highlights...

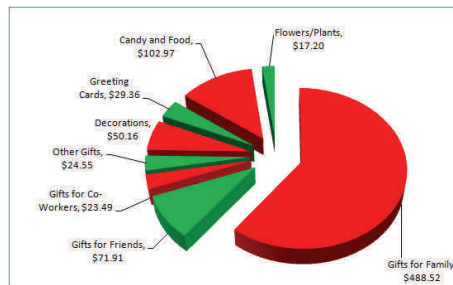
