- o FY18 Project Balance Sheet Drew Struttmann
 - 7 of 8 FY18 projects complete, Old Monroe radio project underway mostly complete, some remaining money to spend down
- FY19 Project Balance Sheet Drew Struttmann
 - Two of eight projects are completed, two are in progress and the remaining four have not yet begun. Three of the eight projects are pending signed sub-award agreements.
- Nominations for vacant positions
 - Michael Daniels nominated Zack Jacobsen for Sheriff alternate, Joseph Blount for Mayor/City Admin alternate, Jeff Benson for Public Works alternate, and Todd Culbertson for School alternate. This was seconded by Robert Bach and passed by a roll call vote.

New Business

Salamander funding is good through August of 2021 based upon 2019 award. There were no Region C applications for the 2020 FY. Currently Region C is the only region paying for Salamander licensing out of awarded funds. All other Regions are acquiring licenses through the State contract. This was decided when Emma was RHSOC chair and is related to personal information being accessible by other entities. The plan was to contact RHSOC agencies to give them an opportunity to remove personal info. Discussion tabled until next meeting.



- FY 2020 funding allocation recommendation was presented and five projects were voted upon by roll
 call. The vote passed by majority as follows:
 - Warren County Badging Printer awarded \$8.177.00
 - Perry County MOSWIN Upgraded awarded 50% of requested amount at \$39,336.80
 - Warren County Health Department POD Project awarded \$3,929.80
 - Small Unmanned Aircraft 030E-07-SUAS awarded \$36,223.94
 - 2020 MOSWIN Radio Integration to Radio Console awarded \$13,109.10

Total amount voted upon matches estimated award amount of \$100,776.64. The vote included a decision to apply any amounts leftover after projects are completed to the Perry County MOSWIN upgrade project.
