- o FY19/FY20 Project Balance Sheets Tim Churchill
 - FY 19 and 20 projects were reviewed for percent completion. Six of the eight FY19 projects are either paid or pending payment. The remaining two are on schedule to complete before end of August 2021. FY20 projects are underway with two of them completed and pending payment. FY20 will end on September 30, 20222.

New Business

 FY21 Funding – Six projects were tentatively approved for funding and four were determined not eligible related to them not being a regional deployable asset. Estimated funding amount is



\$111,982.79. After discussion around the scope of each project a motion was made by Tina Davis and seconded by Tim Porter to fund as follows:

- Elsberry FPD \$24,800.00
- Wright City FPD \$7,800.00
- St. Francois County 911/EMA \$24,800.00
- St. Francois County 911/EMA (Radios) \$17,074.60
- Old Monroe FPD \$12,708.19
