

Request for Qualifications Professional Engineering Services

The Village of Rhineland requests qualifications for engineering services and subsequent engineering design and inspection services to assist in a project to be partially financed with a grant from the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF). The remainder of the project is being financed with Village funds. The project consists of upgrading Stiers Memorial Park. Information provided to the Village must include:

- (a) The specialized experience and technical competence of the firm with respect to Park project design and construction including ADA expertise;
- (b) The capacity and capability of the firm to perform the work in question, including specialized services;
- (c) The past record of performance of the firm with respect to such factors as control of costs, quality of work and ability to meet schedules;
- (d) The firms proximity to and familiarity with the area in which the project is located; and
- (e) References from all previous clients involved with the firm within the past five years;
- (f) Documentation of compliance with E-verify requirements.

Ability to begin work immediately plus (c) above shall receive primary consideration.
