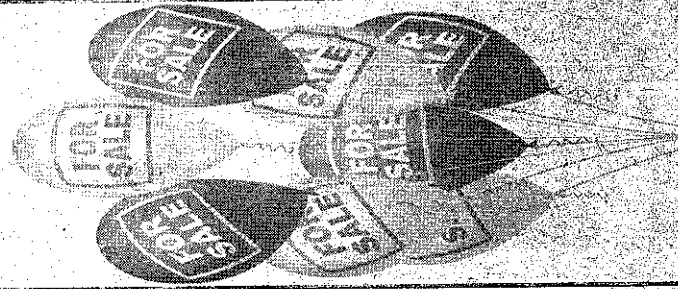

## REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

The City of Truesdale requests qualifications for engineering design and construction inspection services to assist in a proposed street project. The project consists of street improvements and storm water drainage.

Information provided to the city must include:

- 1) The specialized experience and technical competence of the firm with respect to street improvements and storm water drainage or related work.
- 2) The capacity and capability of the firm to perform the work in question; including specialized services, within a period of two months beginning December 15, 2022.
- 3) The past record of performance of the firm with respect to such factors as control of costs, quality of work, and ability to meet schedules.
- 4) The firm's proximity to and familiarity with the area in which the project is located; and
- 5) References from previous clients of related work with the firm within the past five years.
- 6) Documentation of compliance with E-verify requirements.

The firm will be selected based on the above qualifications. Once the most qualified firm is selected, a cost for engineering will be negotiated.
